Ofc. Jeffrey Cobb P108, being first duly swom on oath, deposes and says: That affiant is a Police Officer dommissioned and employed by the Pasco Police Department. That he/she believes that probable cause exists for the arrest and detention of the above-named defendant for RCW 9A.36.031 Assault in the 3rd Degree in that records made and kept in the regular course of business and as business records

The following event occurred on 01/16/2014 at about 22:49 hours while I, Officer Cobb, being a fully commissioned law enforcement officer, on routine and uniformed patrol; in the City of Pasco, Franklin County, Washington, to enforce the laws of the state of Washington, while in marked police unit 13-203.

Pasco Police officers were dispatched to the area of N 8th Avenue and W Bonneville Street in reference to a male causing a disturbance by walking around and hitting cars with a broom. Officer Brewster arrived in the area and spoke with the caller and while speaking with, advised he could hear the male in the area of N 7th Avenue and W Bonneville Street. A male was located in the front yard of 224 N 7th Avenue, who was making a commotion on the front porch.

When I arrived I heard Officer Brewster give three separate and distance commands to the male to drop items in his hand and to come towards him. The male picked up a rocking chair and attempted to throw it at Officer Brewster and was unable to, dropping the chair. The male then picked up a male box and post

thereof reflect as follows:

from the porch and threw these items at Officer Brewster's head, and he had to duck to avoid being struck.

The male then attempted to run from Officer Brewster and I, and as Officer Brewster attempted to follow the male, the male turned around and officer Brewster attempted to take the male into custody. The male then grabbed onto Officer Brewster's belt and grabbed onto the handle of his service pistol. Officer Brewster had no other options and attempted to head butt the male in the right temple to incapacitate him, however, when the male was struck, this had no visible effect on him. The male was taken to the ground and continued to struggle with Officer Brewster and I, and continued grabbing for and grabbing onto Officer Brewster's pistol, attempting to free it from the holster.

I utilized my electronic control device, and we were able to take the male into custody. Due to the male's erratic behavior, he was transported to Our Lady of Lourdes Hospital ER and medically cleared. While at the ER he admitted to using methamphetamines. Once cleared the male was transported and booked into the Franklin County Jail and a charge of RCW 9A.36.031 Assault in the 3rd degree.
